I thought the following might be appropriate if applied to getting new members:

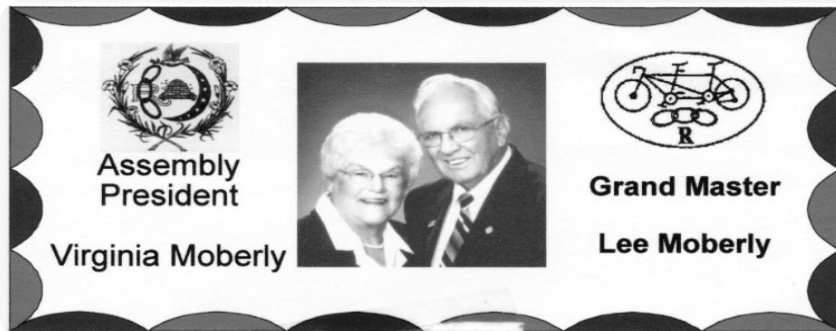
"THAT'S NOT MY JOB"
