Nampa - On July 16, 2015, Cortni Chandler embarked on an experience of a lifetime thanks to Nampa Odd Fellows Lodge #40. Cortni was supported by Nampa #40 to attend the United Nations Pilgrimage. She traveled to Denver, Colorado to join several Colorado students and Colorado's Past Grand Master Doug Pittman (now Colorado's Grand Secretary) before traveling with them to Philadelphia where they met the rest

of the group. They spent the evening in Philadelphia where they experienced the hospitality of the Odd Fellows Walker Lodge #306. The following day they loaded a bus to Washington DC. While in DC, the group visited many historic sites such as, the Vietnam Memorial, Lincoln Monument, The White House, and the Smithsonian. The next stop was New York. The United Nations building was incredible. The delegates participated in a speech contest. They were asked to research the Seventeen Sustainable Developmental Goals of the UN. Cortni chose 5 of the goals and explained to the group how these goals were significant to her community of Nampa, Idaho. After sharing the speeches, the delegates were treated to a tour of the Statue of Liberty, the Empire State Building, the 911 Reflection pool, and the Broadway musical, "Rotten". After their time in New York, they headed off to Salem, Massachusetts and then on to Canada. In Canada they experienced Niagara Falls, which was awe inspiring. The Canadian Parliament building was also on their tour. After two days in Canada, they headed back to Philadelphia via Corning, New York where they got to see the amazing glass creations at the Corning Museum of Glass. The hardest part of returning to Philadelphia was having to say goodbye to the amazing friends that Cortni made. This was truly an experience of a lifetime.

Get Your Name Out There!

Fraternal Greetings from your Odd Fellow and Rebekah Membership Chairmen! This month we would like to emphasize advertising techniques. Having events at your lodge is a great step toward getting people in your hall, but it won't do much good if no one knows it is happening. In any advertising campaign the first step is always evaluating your target demographic. Focus your efforts on the methods that can reach a large number of your target population with as little effort as possible.

There are many great ways to spread the word about your lodge and its happenings – some old, some new. Tried and true methods such as fliers, signs, and word-of-mouth are good ways to get the community's attention on the street. These techniques are great for meeting people and personalizing the lodge, but they take a lot of time and energy. Newspaper ads bring attention to events like yard sales, but many people are now looking online for things to do. Your town may already have a website dedicated to a calendar of events, so contacting your local Chamber is good place to start. The State of Idaho even has its own website for upcoming events that anyone can post on. Simply go to <http://www.idahocalendar.com>. Using newspaper articles and websites to advertise lodge happenings can reach a wide range of people while minimizing effort.

If your lodge doesn't already have a website or social media page, you should consider creating one. Remember, our goal is to bring smiling new faces into our lodge halls. Facebook is a great way to start reaching out to those around you and is a great platform to target the younger generation. You can post photos, fliers, messages, and more on your page for everyone to view. Do a simple search for groups in your area created for advertisements such as buying/selling/trading (classifieds), volunteer opportunities, local happenings, etc. There are LOTS of lodges already on Facebook. The Sovereign Grand Lodge and our Idaho Grand Lodge and Rebekah Assembly have pages, there are many group pages to join where you can learn lots of neat lodge information and ask questions, and many Idaho members are on it, too! It's easy to become friends with members across the U.S. and even the globe. Embrace the internet – it can really help your lodge go far.

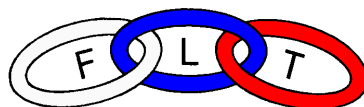
