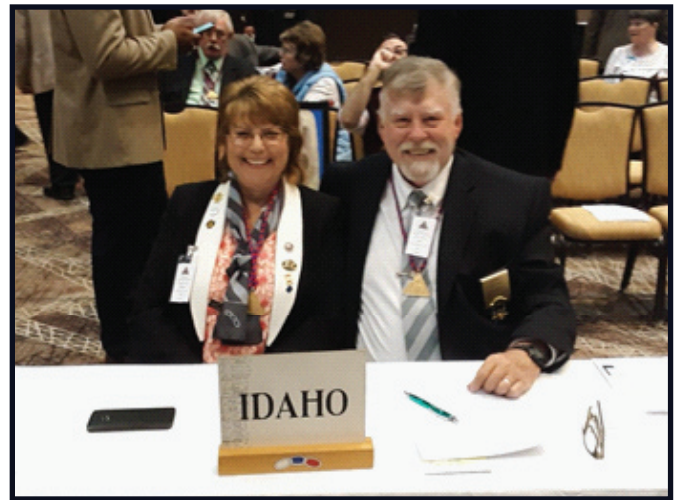
Ada Lodge #3 2nd Annual G. I. Joe Breakfast

Carnation Rebekahs Started In 1910 With 10 Members

Post Falls - Carnation Rebekah Lodge No. 95 of Post Falls, Idaho was instituted on March 30, 1910. Seven Sisters and three Brothers from Naome Rebekah Lodge No. 16 of Coeur d'Alene transferred here and six Sisters and five Brothers were elected membership and initiated by the Drill Team from Naome #15. Initiation fees for Sisters were \$2.50 and for Brothers \$3.00 and the dues were \$2.50 for Sisters and \$3.00 for Brothers.

All went well for a number of years then interest in lodge failed and many nights no meetings were held. The Odd Fellows lost their hall, so they had to move into the Nagles Hall for meetings, after a short time they talked of consolidating, after paying the Hall rent a per capita tax etc. there was just \$8.58 left in the treasury. So on Sept. 5, 1916, they consolidated with Naomi No. 16 of Coeur d'Alene. Then on the afternoon of May 13, 1921 the charter was again taken up and the lodge was again active.

The membership has steadily increased and on April 8, 1969 Cedar Rebekah Lodge No. 42 of Spirit Lake consolidated with Carnation No. 95. Several members have held offices in the Rebekah Assembly and Sister Alta McMinimy has served as President of the Rebekah Assembly and tow Brothers, Ray Rollins and Don McMinimy have both served as Grand Masters.

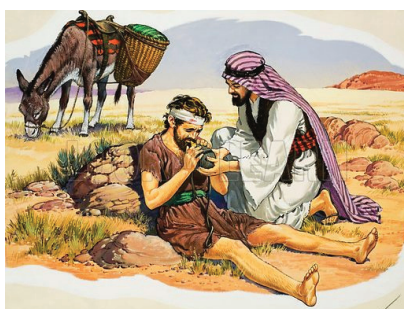
